4. Have the apartment owners been encouraged to improve the wind resistance of their apartment?
5. Do you have an Incident Management Plan, (i.e., a plan to follow during a natural or man-made emergency or disasters)?
6. Does the condominium have an Incident Management Center, (i.e., a safe and secure location where guidance and direction to occupants can be coordinated and communicated to them)?
7. Does the condominium have an emergency communication system?
8. Does the condominium have an emergency stand-by power generator? If yes, what is the capacity? What is the fuel storage capacity?
9. Will the condominium provide shelter to non-condominium individuals?
10. Are you aware of the provisions of Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) 128-19 which gives private shelters certain limited liability coverage?
11. If the condominium cannot be used for sheltering the occupants, what arrangements have been made to ensure the safety of its occupants?
12. If you plan to send your condominium occupants to a public shelter in the vicinity, have you coordinated this intent with your County Civil Defense organization?
